Ruth's Chris Steak House to open Odenton location

Klein Enterprises announced Friday that Ruth's Chris Steak House is set to open Monday at The Village at Odenton Station in west Anne Arundel County, opposite the Odenton MARC Rail Station and near Ft. Meade, the National Security Agency and National Business Park.

Baltimore Orioles Hall of Famer Rick Dempsey is expected to greet customers and sign autographs from 5 to 7 p.m. during the opening.

Klein Enterprises manages the retail leasing for The Village at Odenton Station, which is owned by The Dolben Company.



Construction began in April on the 8,600-square-foot restaurant, which features a bar, open dining room, banquet rooms and an outdoor patio.

At The Village at Odenton Station, the restaurant anchors 57,000 square feet of commercial space, which includes Kiddie Academy, Baltimore Coffee & Tea, Physiotherapy Associates and other retail/service tenants, all beneath 235 residential apartments. There are also more than 7,000 hotel rooms within a 15-minute drive, more than 2,600 daily MARC commuters and a fast-growing, professional population with household income levels in excess of the state average.
