

Ruth's Chris Steak House construction begins at Odenton Station



Ruth's Chris construction begins, more businesses open at Odenton Station

Construction on the national chain Ruth's Chris Steak House has started at the Village at Odenton Station and two new businesses are now open, according to real estate company Klein Enterprises.

In a release, the company said that the steak house is expected to open by Labor Day while Kiddie Academy, a child care center, and Physiotherapy Associates, an outpatient physical and occupational rehabilitation center, are both now open.

Officials with the West County Chamber of Commerce announced last year the steak house would be occupying the corner space of the shopping center. Ruth's Chris has seven locations in Maryland, including one of Severn Avenue in Eastport.

In the release, Klein Enterprises said it "will feature a bar, open dining room, banquet rooms and an outdoor patio."

Physiotherapy Associates will share space with Advanced Spine and Pain, according to the company. Both it and Kiddie Academy opened last month.

"With the opening of these businesses at The Village at Odenton Station, we are able to provide the community with a diverse range of services – dining, childcare and health," said Trish Palumbo, Director of Leasing for Klein Enterprises.

"We want The Village at Odenton Station to provide the community with the amenities it needs."



Last month, Anne Arundel County Council voted 6 to 1 to update the town center's master plan, which included visions of green space, bike- and pedestrian-friendly pathways and mixed-use projects on 1,200 next to the Odenton MARC station.
