Klein Enterprises gets new tenant for Va. shopping center

Sweet Home Furniture will open a new location at Market at Opitz Crossing, the 157,724 square-foot shopping center in Woodbridge, Virginia, that was acquired by Baltimore-based Klein Enterprises in June.

The 10,550-square-foot store is expected to open in January 2018.

Market at Opitz Crossing is Klein Enterprises' third retail asset in Virginia, following the development of Stafford Corner in 2014 and the acquisition of Pleasant Valley Shopping Center in 2016. This will be the third Sweet Home Furniture in the market following openings in Hyattsville and Falls Church, Virginia.
